**Bethlehem Wind** is an Advent anthem. Suggested corresponding lectionary readings include Psalm 72, Isaiah 11: 1-10, Matthew 2: 1-12, John 3: 1-8 and Romans 15: 4-13. One basic homiletical theme is "living in the Spirit," sustained by God's great gifts of hope, peace, love and joy and led by the promises of God's Son, the Messiah.

In rehearsal, strive for a flowing legato, sensitive text declamation and a feeling of one pulse per measure. Sing the opening section (mm. 9-40) on the neutral syllable "noo" while articulating a steady stream of quarter notes. Allow the quarter note pulse to give shape to the phrases, sculpting them dynamically and imbuing each with a strong sense of motion. If a flute is available in performance, carefully balance it with the ensemble as it soars like the wind.
